





Medical Id

- Open Health app  and tap the Summary tab.
- Tap your profile picture...
- Under your profile picture, tap Medical Id, Tap Edit in upper right
- Enter Key info, i.e. blood type, medical conditions, etc. Below Emergency Contacts, tap Add Emergency Contact, then add your contacts.
- After an emergency call ends, your iPhone alerts your emergency contacts with a text message, unless you cancel. Your iPhone sends your current location and—for a period of time after you enter SOS mode—your emergency contacts receive updates when your location changes.
- To make your Medical ID available from the lock screen on your iPhone, turn on 'Show When Locked.' and Share During Emergency Call




In Case It's Lost




- Make a Photo with contact info to use when creating a Wallpaper to put on your lock screen in case your device is lost.
- First open **Photos**
- Tap on Photo you want to use
- Tap Edit Slider icon
- Tap Edit, Select **Markup** icon
- Tap Plus **+**
- Tap **Text**
- Type your email or partner's phone #
- This has created a photo you can use in Wallpaper setup in Settings

Crop It Quick



Before you used to have to tap it, select edit, and find the crop tool. Not anymore.

Just open an image and do the two-finger zoom-in, either in portrait or landscape mode.

A Crop button appears at the upper right. Tap it and the image is instantly whittled down to what you see on the screen. (You can always go back in to Edit the image and restore it.)




Find that pic, vid,...they sent me



Tired of scrolling through Messages threads looking for photos and links friends and family have sent you? Find them the easy way; here's how!

1. Open the **Messages** app.
2. Tap the message thread where you want to see what was shared with you.
3. Tap the Arrow next to the contact's name. Then again Tap the Arrow at the top with Name
4. Tap See All to see attachments in Collaboration, Photos, Links, and any other categories.







Handoff From One Device to Another




- Copy and Paste between devices –
- Simply highlight and select copy, then go to other device (iPad, Laptop, Mac desktop) and Paste (on iPad, press and hold where you want to paste and select Paste,
- On Laptop, place cursor and press command V or Edit at top and select Paste.







Free Up Space

- While you're in Settings , you can free up some space on your device by offloading Apps you rarely use.
- Settings > App Store and turn on Offload Unused Apps.
- Apps then disappear from your phone when you don't use them after a few weeks. Any data or docs related to the app remain, though, so if you reinstall, it'll still be of use. This is a great trick to use when you're a heavy gamer, since games can take up a lot of space. Free some up space for new fun. **Note**, however, if an app is offloaded and then removed from the App Store in the meantime, you will not be able to download it again.







Schedule a Message





- With ios18 you can press the + sign next to the message input area and get choices of several actions.
- A new choice is to Send Later.
- Write your message, press the + sign and select Send Later, choose your time (even up to two weeks)



Photos — Search








- When viewing a monthly calendar you might not see the detail you need to see

Create Text Replacements




Are there phrases you find yourself typing over and over, like "On the way home" or "Love you more than the sun and moon!"?

- **Settings > General > Keyboard > Text Replacement.**

Click the plus (+) icon at the top to enter a **Phrase** and then a **Shortcut**. Then, any time you type the shortcut (such as "otw"), the full phrase (say, "I'm on the way home, leave me alone!") springs to life on the keyboard's text preview. Hit the return key and it's accepted.




★ You can even use this trick to type a letter combo that brings up a specific series of emoji.



Forget your Wifi?




- Go to Settings > **Wi-Fi** and click the info icon (the “i” in a circle) next to the network name.
- The WiFi password on the info screen is still blanked out
- Tap it, authenticate, and it will reveal. You’ll be given the option to copy it or speak it.



Quickly Get Flight Info



- Using an iMessage sent to you with Flight number or send one to yourself with the flight number
- Press and Hold on the number
- Select Preview Flight



Apple TV



Works like any other Apple Device

- **Use Siri** to navigate to a different app. press the Siri button and ask, “what did he say?”. The "what did he say?" Siri command on Apple TV can be used to rewind the current video and turn on closed captions for a short period of time, allowing you to better understand what was said.
- In videos tell Siri to rewind 2 mins or go forward 1 min or 30 min maybe in case of a sports replay.
- Fast switch between apps: double click the button with a TV on it then scroll through recent apps. Just like the App Switcher concept on iPhone/iPad.
- To move apps around on the Apple TV home screen, just hold the select button over any icon until it jiggles, then use the direction pad to change its position. AppleTV also lets you sort apps into folders. To do this, long-press any app, hit the play button on your remote, then select “New Folder” or choose an existing one.





- This is a tease for an upcoming class for **Assistive Touch** and **Assistive Access** because there is just too much to do in a Tech Talk like this that covers several Tips.







Caller Emergency Bypass





- Launch the **Contacts** app
- Select a contact
- Tap **Edit** in the top-right corner of the screen
- Tap **Text Tone** or **Ringtone**
- At the top, you'll **Emergency Bypass**
- Press the toggle to green
- Tap **Done**



Magically eject water



- Install Water Eject Shortcut from Shortcut Gallery
- Launch Shortcuts
- Search Water Eject, Tap Shortcut



Using the Latest?

- To be sure you are using the latest updates to your Apps. You can set it so that the App Store updates your apps automatically .
- Go to Settings > App Store and in Automatic Downloads, turn on App Updates.
